

On a small collection of Aquatic Beetles from Dudhwa Tiger Reserve, Uttar Pradesh, India

Dudhwa National Park (DNP) is located at Indo-Nepal border of Lakhimpur-Kheri district, which comes under Terai region of the state of Uttar Pradesh. The park harbours natural forest of moist deciduous type and grasslands which provides suitable habitats for entomofauna. DNP with 680 sq. km. area, Krishnapur Wildlife Sanctuary (204 sq. km.) and KaterniaGhat Wildlife Sanctuary (440 sq. km.) constitutes together the Dudhwa Tiger Reserve. There are number of shallow lakes or pools, diverse perennial sources of fresh water in the park. Suheli and Mohana streams flowing through the DNP provides the best possible habitats for luxuriant growth of forests and diverse aquatic insect fauna. The most important lakes of the park includes Bankeytaal and Bhaditaal.

The current knowledge of aquatic beetle fauna of Protected Areas of Uttar Pradesh is limited to the works of Ghosh (2011) who reported aquatic beetle fauna from Sandi Bird Sanctuary and Ghosh et.al. (2011) published a paper on Suraha Tal WildLife Sanctuary. The present paper is based on a small collection of aquatic beetles, collected from different parts of Dudhwa Tiger Reserve by authors in February 2011. Altogether 11 species belonging to 8 genera and 3 families (Noteridae, Dytiscidae and Hydrophilidae) of aquatic Coleoptera were recorded during this survey. All the species are recorded for the first time from DNP.

I. Family Noteridae

II. Family Dytiscidae

Elsewhere: Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, China, Cyprus, Iran, Iraq, Japan, Kyrgyzstan, Mongolia, Russia, Syria, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Turkey, Uzbekistan and Europe.

6. *Laccophilus flexuosus* Aube, 1838

Distribution: (India): (Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Andhra Pradesh, New Delhi, Jharkhand, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Odisha, Puducherry, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal).

Elsewhere: China, Honkong, Indonesia, Iran, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka.

7. *Laccophilus sharpi* Regimbart, 1889

Elsewhere: China, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka.

8. *Laccophilus uniformis* Motschulsky, 1859

III. Family **Hydrophilidae**

Distribution: (India): Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Jammu & Kashmir, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Manipur, Punjab, S. India, Sikkim, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal.

Elsewhere: Sunda Is., Myanmar, Philippines, Japan, Taiwan, Indonesia, Indochina, China and Sri Lanka.

10. *Berosus pulchellus* Macleay, 1817

Materials examined: 4exs.

Distribution: (India): Andhra Pradesh, Delhi, Haryana, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Meghalaya, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal.

Elsewhere: China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, Nepal, Philippines, Sri Lanka and Taiwan.

11. *Regimbertia attenuata* Fabricius, 1801

Materials examined: 3exs.

Distribution: (India): Andhra Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Bihar, Jammu & Kashmir, Manipur, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal.

Elsewhere: Sri Lanka, S. Asia, Philippines, Sunda Is., Australia, Japan, Taiwan, Indonesia, Cambodia, Vietnam and Indochina.
