The International Year of Biodiversity is a unique opportunity to increase understanding of the vital role that biodiversity plays in sustaining life on Earth.



An agreement was signed between the Secretariat and the World Association of Zoos and Aquariums (WAZA) on 5 October. The objective of the agreement is to provide a framework for cooperation between the two organizations. Potential areas of
