After my secondary studies in school, I did one year industrial course PPO in ITI and worked in a private industry for 3 months. After 4 years, I started working as an Editorial Assistant for Zoos' Print Journal from June 2004 to till 2007. When ZOOS' PRINT Journal morphed into the Journal of Threatened Taxa (JoTT), I worked under Sanjay which is quite the difficult task!

I would like to say few words of ZOO employees individually also. **Sally Walker** - I admired her work and dedication to wildlife conservation. She has given her life for ZOO and working without salary for the last two decades. **Sanjay Molur** - a knowledgeable person in all the subjects!!
