

## Sri Lankan Reptile Red List, Key Biodiversity Areas (KBA), & Assessment 2 Planning (A2P) Workshop

14-19 September 2019, Simpson's Forest Hotel, Wattegama, Kandy

Over 185 Sri Lanka Reptile species were evaluated for the IUCN Red List status — 102 species Threatened and 12 species Data Deficient. 33 KBAs identified — 10 within existing IBAs and 23 newly formed.
