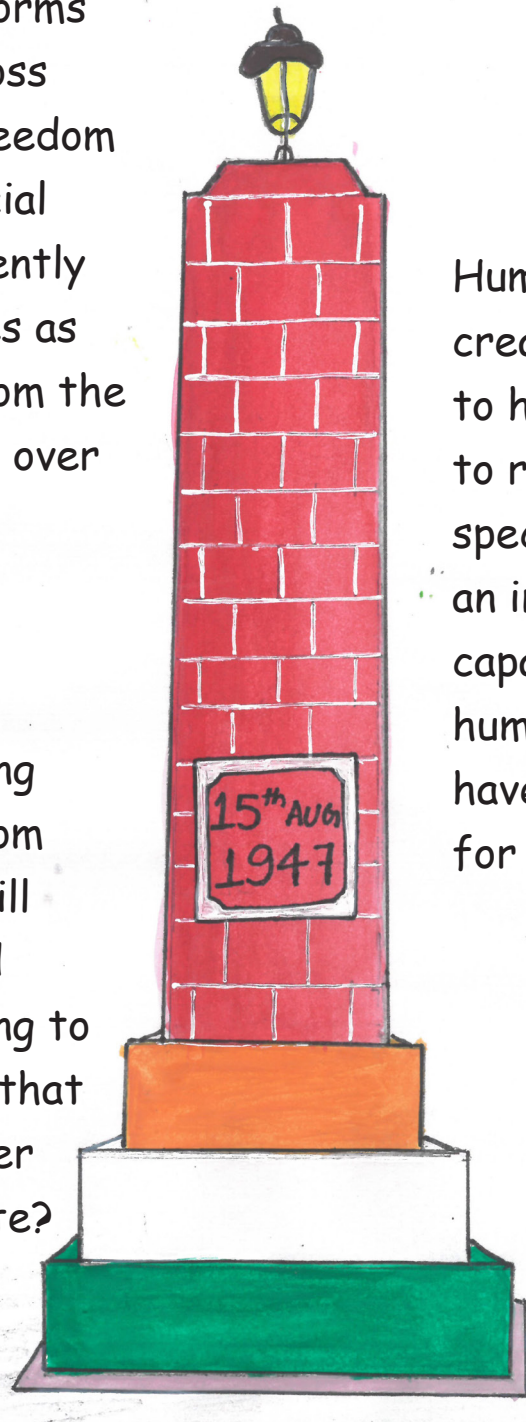


# UNSCRUPULOUS
