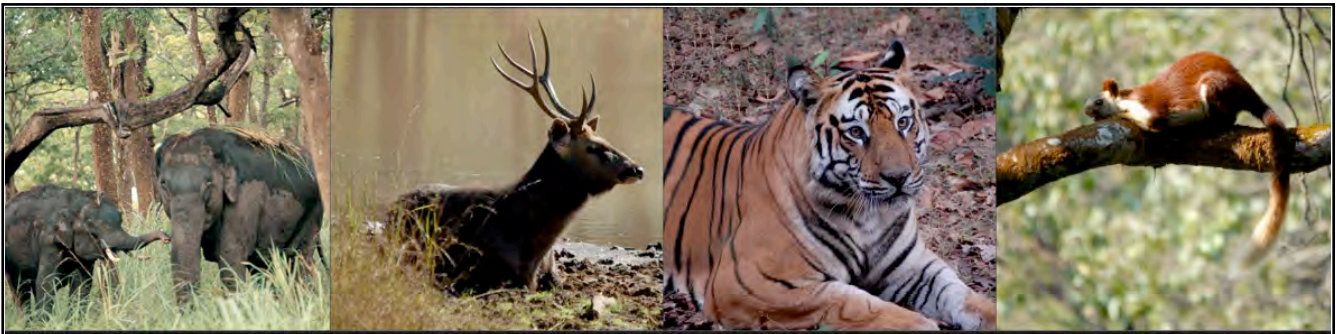

17th International Wildlife Law Conference 6-7 January 2017, Pune, India

The 17th International Wildlife Law Conference will be held in Pune, India at the Institute of Environment Education and Research, Bharati Vidyapeeth University from 6-9 January 2017.
